## The Upcoming Year In Epidemiology - 2024

We are pleased to present our annual calendar of worldwide epidemiology and biostatistics events. As always, these events are categorized as conventions/meetings, short courses, and Summer/Winter programs. The list is built based on submissions from the sponsoring entities, events that have been historically listed in our calendar, and web searches to uncover new events to add to the list. PQHS faculty members maintain collaborative interactions with various institutional (e.g. Engineering, the Mandel School of Applied Social Sciences, etc.), local (e.g. the Ohio Department of Health, etc.), national, and international partners.

Applicants must have a PhD, MD or equivalent doctoral degree; Applicants for Associate or Full Professor level should demonstrate a record of peer-reviewed extramural funding commensurate with rank. Applicants for Assistant Professor should explain their potential for obtaining peer-reviewed extramural funding. All applicants are expected to possess collaborative skills, contribute to teaching (*i.e.* one course per year), and show a commitment to the education and mentorship of trainees, with attention to underrepresented individuals. ## Multiple Research Fellowships Pediatric Cancer / Translational & Genomic Research

The University of Minnesota Department of Pediatrics and Masonic Cancer Center seeks applicants for its highly successful training program in translational and genomic pediatric cancer epidemiology research. Our program is sought nationally by scholars seeking to learn about childhood cancer, and provides opportunities for 1 predoctoral and 3 postdoctoral trainees at any given time. Fellows gain experience across the spectrum of pediatric cancer research from etiology to outcome of therapy to survivorship, with a goal of interdisciplinary cross-training.

Predocotoral students must be formally admitted to the graduate school PhD program in Epidemiology. Postdoctoral trainees are drawn from the medical, basic and applied sciences, including medical fellows in the Department of Pediatrics who have completed advanced clinical training in pediatric oncology. Special attention is given to recruitment of individuals under-represented in medicine. Each trainee is guided by at least two senior mentors from complementary disciplines in their research projects.

All trainees participate in courses in pediatric cancer topics and readings in pediatric cancer epidemiology, biweekly pediatric cancer seminar meetings and pediatric tumor conferences, monthly seminars, and an annual retreat focused on pediatric cancer epidemiology and professional development. Trainees are strongly encouraged to present their own research at national and international meetings with travel funds provided. Postdoctoral trainees receive additional training in grant writing/preparation. All receive instruction in the responsible conduct of research.

Trainees who graduate from this program, will have the capacity to undertake high impact population pediatric cancer epidemiology research will cross-training in complementary disciplines.

## Chair and Tenured Full Professor Faculty Position Department of Epidemiology and Biostatistics

The Department of Epidemiology and Biostatistics at Indiana University School of Public Health-Bloomington (IU SPH-B) invites applications for the position of Chair and Tenured Full Professor. We are seeking applicants with strong research, leadership, and administrative records, who value our dual disciplines of Epidemiology and Biostatistics and the interdisciplinary space between them, and who will be champions for faculty, student, and staff success.

Individuals are sought who will contribute multidisciplinary perspectives, conceptual and methodological diversity, and research leadership and mentoring strengths to the Department's efforts toward academic excellence in research and to teach approaches for primordial, primary, secondary, and tertiary disease prevention in order to ultimately improve public health in Indiana and beyond. This 12-month appointment would ideally start July 1, 2024 although a different hire date is possible. **Qualifications:** Candidates must hold a doctoral degree in epidemiology, biostatistics or a closely related field, ideally from an accredited school of public health or related educational institution. ## Faculty Fellow Research Assistant Professor Bridge to Faculty Program

The Department of Epidemiology and Biostatistics (DEB) in the Arnold School of Public Health (ASPH) ([www.sph.sc.edu](http://www.sph.sc.edu)) at the University of South Carolina (USC) invites applications for a Faculty Fellow at the rank of Research Assistant Professor to join USC's Bridge to Faculty program. Bridge to Faculty is a program designed to recruit talented early-career scholars as Faculty Fellows at the rank of Research Assistant Professor with the goal of transitioning them to tenure-track faculty members after two years. Bridge to Faculty aims to attract and retain promising scholars with an emphasis on underrepresented early-career scholars.

We invite applications from outstanding scholars whose work contributes to, advances, or expands the boundaries of epidemiology or biostatistics and will have completed a doctoral degree (e.g., PhD, ScD, DrPH) in epidemiology or biostatistics or related disciplines between July 1, 2019, and July 1, 2024. Candidates should demonstrate evidence of potential for high-quality scholarly research and the potential for excellence in teaching and competing for external research funding. Candidates with research expertise from all areas of epidemiology and biostatistics will be considered. Examples of epidemiology faculty expertise are infectious disease epidemiology, genetic epidemiology, epidemiology of aging, perinatal epidemiology, cancer epidemiology, social epidemiology, nutritional epidemiology, and epidemiology of cardiometabolic outcomes. Examples of biostatistics faculty expertise are multivariate analysis, high-dimensional data analysis, multilevel modeling, network analysis, Bayesian modeling and survival analysis, genetics, brain imaging, functional data analysis, longitudinal data analysis, and precision medicine.

**How to apply:** Qualified candidates should submit the following: 1) cover letter describing your interest in being a Bridge to Faculty scholar at USC, with relevant personal and professional background. Identify 1-2 departmental faculty members who could serve as your mentor(s). 2) curriculum vitae; 3) transcripts (indicating completion of PhD after July 1, 2019 or expected completion of PhD by July 1, 2024); 4) research statement; 5) teaching statement; 6) a statement sharing how your experiences related to diversity, equity, and inclusion can help advance USC's goal of cultivating a more diverse, equitable, and inclusive campus (1-3 pages). Varied socioeconomic and cultural experiences, diversity-related research, teaching goals emphasizing diversity, and first-generation college graduate status should be highlighted in the statement; 7) up to two writing samples; 8) three letters of recommendation. If you have not yet defended your dissertation, include a letter from your dissertation supervisor confirming that the PhD will be completed by July 1, 2024.
