The Upcoming Year In Epidemiology - 2024

We are pleased to present our annual calendar of worldwide epidemiology and biostatistics events. As always, these events are categorized as conventions/meetings, short courses, and Summer/Winter programs. PQHS faculty members maintain collaborative interactions with various institutional (*e.g.* Engineering, the Mandel School of Applied Social Sciences, *etc.*), local (*e.g.* the Ohio Department of Health, *etc.*), national, and international partners.

Applicants must have a PhD, MD or equivalent doctoral degree; Applicants for Associate or Full Professor level should demonstrate a record of peer-reviewed extramural funding commensurate with rank. Applicants for Assistant Professor should explain their potential for obtaining peer-reviewed extramural funding. The University of Minnesota Department of Pediatrics and Masonic Cancer Center seeks applicants for its highly successful training program in translational and genomic pediatric cancer epidemiology research.
